

Sharing Learning in Communities is a partnership project founded by the European Union under the 'Lifelong Learning Programme'. It started in summer 2012 and will be finished in summer 2014. The partnership consists of 9 partners, enterprises, NGO's as well as public institutions, from different EU-countries. The project will provide opportunities for community educators to share new, innovative and practical ideas and methods within a changing society. The focus will be: engaging people from disadvantaged communities, vulnerable social groups, and different ages to use learning for active citizenship. All countries of the EU are currently experiencing economic, political and social crises, but despite these national differences there are some solutions which have common themes. Therefore the partnership is working together to share knowledge and experiences in dealing with social inequality, the challenge of an aging population and the need to increase active citizenship. To disseminate the project's outcomes more widely the partners will create a series of themed newsletters.
